Gaughan urges Town Board to accept resizing referendum

Kevin P. Gaughan, the Buffalo lawyer challenging local governments to reduce their numbers of elected officials, is urging the West Seneca Town Board to do the right thing when members meet tonight by acquiescing to a public referendum this November.

Gaughan recently won his second court decision allowing citizens to decide whether to reduce the Town Board from five members to three.

“Your choice this Monday night is simple,” Gaughan wrote in a letter to the board Friday, “You can comply with the law, choose a date for the vote and select the proposition language you want to appear on the ballot. Or you can defy the court, ignore the will of the people, and send your attorneys to Rochester to argue for a third time what you have already lost in court twice. And in the process, force West Seneca taxpayers to pay tens of thousands of dollars more.”
